



Branch Out

Cherry blossoms bloom only briefly, but these tissue paper versions can last all spring.

Layer a sheet of dark pink paper atop light pink paper. Using the patterns provided (or your own!) cut out around the outside edges of the pattern several flowers that are 2 to 4 inches in diameter.

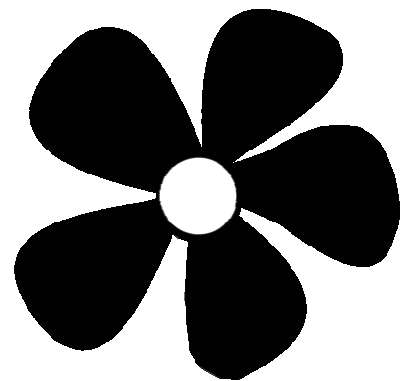
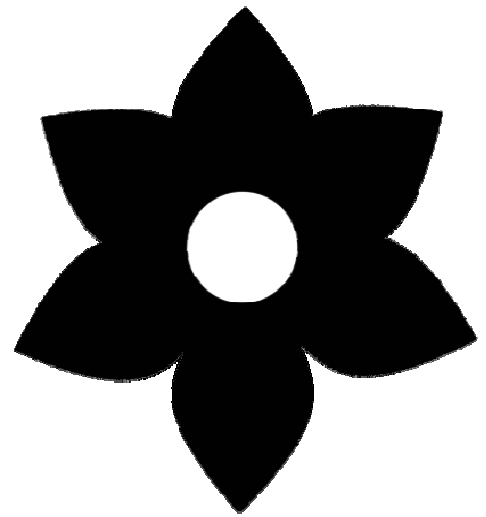
Once cut, position the dark pink petals so that they do not align with the light pink ones by slightly turning the dark ones in a clockwise direction.

Press in the center of the flower. From underneath slightly twist the flower and wrap with floral wire. Make several flowers.

Hot-glue all onto a bare branch. Repeat, varying sizes of flowers so blossoms look realistic.

Place branches into a tall vase – you can use a colored or a clear vase with clear or colored stones for a dramatic display!
