

Wall Calendar

Memories by Tena Sprenger

Does your teen have enough activities, appointments and achievements to cause your planner to overflow? To help her daughter keep track of everything she's got going on, Tena Sprenger designed a custom calendar that doubles as a keepsake book for milestones and photos.

How To:

Create a backboard for the calendar by covering corrugated cardboard with patterned paper. Create the calendar by nesting and stitching embellished file folders. Embellish each page with a mini calendar, photos and notes. Attach pages to the backboard with brads.

Tena's Tip:

An easy way to "wallpaper" surfaces with paper is with a glue stick and brayer. Completely coat the back of the paper with adhesive, place it on a flat surface, then run a brayer over it to help it sit securely without bubbles and wrinkles.

Supplies

Patterned papers:

Captured Elements and Making Memories; *Twill:* C.M. Offray & Son; *Textured cardstock and brads:* Bazzill Basics Paper; *Minicalendars:* Basics Paper Company; *Waxed linen thread:*

Lineco; *Vinyl letters:* Deflecto; *Stamping ink:* Ranger Industries; *Metal disk:* Provo Craft; *Mini brads:* Lasting Impressions for Paper; *Rubber stamps:* Postmodern Design; *Other:* Manila folders, corrugated cardboard and staples.
