Looking for fun ways to introduce children to America's favorite hobby? Scrapbooking is a creative, inspiring, and educational way to encourage children to express themselves. You Will Need: Empty jar, patterned paper, letter and sun stickers, ribbon, tag

Variation

step-by-step:

Summer-Fun Jar

1. Adhere a strip of patterned paper around a jar.
2. Create a tag and add the words "Summer Fun."
3. Tie a ribbon around the top of the jar. Add the tag to the ribbon.
4. Write a list of summer activities. Cut them into individual strips, fold each strip in half and place inside the jar.
