

4 Simple Tricks for Impressive Gift Wrap

- 1. Mix it up.** Choose two coordinating papers, and wrap boxes in each of them.

- 3. Go simple.** Again, the key is variety. And simple is a good variety! Especially if you can do it with just one little twist, like quadrupling ribbon (twine... my favorite) before tying a basic bow.
- 4. Go funky.** Get creative with trying to use the opposite paper in lieu of a bow. Here, we have a bloomin' flower of brown paper. You can even curl most paper (gently) with scissors, just like you would ribbon.
