

# Felted Pom-Pom Teddy

## Lion Brand® Fishermen's Wool

Materials needed:

150-123 Fishermen's Wool Yarn: Oatmeal

Pom Pom Maker

Small piece of brown felt

Sewing needle and thread

Craft glue

Black puffy paint

GAUGE:

Exact gauge is not essential to this project.



### BEAR

Following package directions on pom pom maker, make one large pom-pom for head and one medium pom-pom for body.

### Felting

Place one finished pom-pom into an old nylon stocking. Knot stocking just above pom-pom. Place second pom-pom into stocking and knot again. Wash pom-pom filled stocking by machine on a hot wash/cold rinse cycle with detergent and several pieces of clothing to agitate. Remove stocking from machine. Remove pom-poms from stocking and roll between your hands to shape. Allow pom-poms to dry completely.

### MUZZLE

From felt, cut a 3/4 in. (2 cm) diameter circle.

### EARS, ARMS, and LEGS

From felt, cut 6 D shaped pieces, with straight side about 1/2 in. (1.5 cm) long.

### FINISHING

Glue head to body. With thread, embroider straight stitch nose onto Muzzle. Using blanket stitch, sew Muzzle and Ears to head, Arms and Legs to body. Apply a dot of puffy paint for each eye.
