

# Jack O'Lantern Garland



---

## What you need :

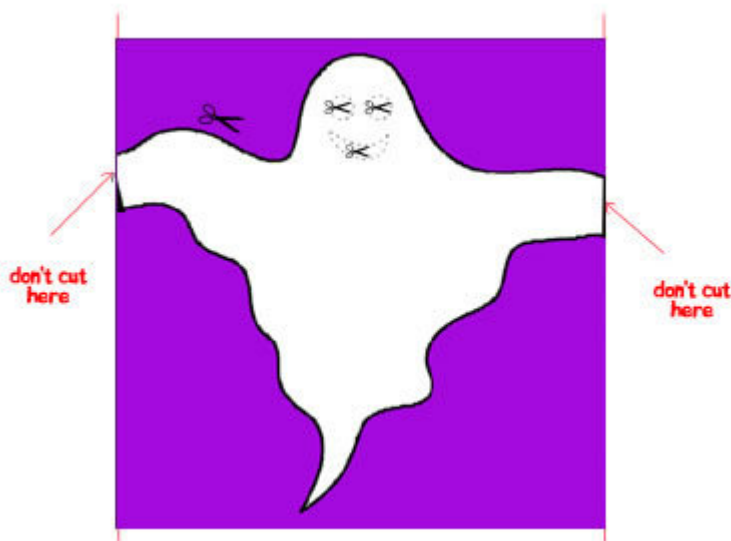
- crêpe paper (white, orange or mauve)
- scissors
- lead pencil
- ruler
- transparent scotch tape
- two or three paper clips
- model of pumpkin and ghost

- 1) Cut a 14 centimeters wide strip of orange crêpe paper. Cut several strips and stick them together with a piece of scotch tape. You can create your garland as long as you wish.
  - 2) Fold the strip accordion style, about 18 centimeters each zigzag fold. Then fix it with some paper clips.
  - 3) Print the Halloween pumpkin model then trace it. Cut outlines and eyes, nose and mouth.
  - 4) Put the pumpkin model on the crepe paper. Draw the outlines, the eyes, nose and mouth as well.
  - 5) Now cut the paper following the outlines of the drawing. Be careful, don't cut the left and right side of crepe paper. Look at the picture below to see how to cut your picture.



## Phantom garland

- 1) Cut a 16 centimeters wide strip of white or mauve crêpe paper.  
Cut several strips and stick them together with a piece of scotch tape.  
You can create your garland as long as you want.
- 2) Fold the strip accordion style, about 16 centimeters each zigzag fold.  
Then fix it with some paper clips.
- 3) Print the Halloween phantom model then trace it. Cut outlines and eyes, nose and mouth.
- 4) Put the phantom model on the crêpe paper. Draw the outlines, the eyes, nose and mouth as well.
- 5) Now cut the paper following the outlines of the drawing. Be careful, don't cut the left and right side of crepe paper. Look at the picture below to see how to cut your picture.



**You can also use the crêpe paper to make confetti!**
