Use large stamps as accents on your layouts for big impact.

Hero Materials:

- CH136 Small Accent Pearl
- CH258 Mixed Blush Buttons
- PW110 Embossing Powder - White
- CG313 Word Pops
- CL508 Luscious Patterned Flowers
- CL518 Flourish Leaves and Flower
- AF185 Chalk Ink: Snow
- AF195 Pumice Stone Distress Dye Ink Pad
- VC250 VersaMark Watermark Stamp Pad
- PS597 Carnation Layering Papers
- PS600 Daffodil Layering Papers
- PS602 Grass Layering Papers
- PS610 Snow Layering Papers
- PS627 Kraft Paper

Additional Materials:

Patterned Paper (Fancy Pants), Ribbon (Cosmo Cricket), Border Punch (EK Success), Circle Punch (Marvy Uchida), Butterfly Punch (Martha Stewart), Scalloped Circle Punch (EK Success), Font-Century Gothic, Glimmer Mist (Tattered Angels), Colored Pencils

Instructions:

1. Stamp the "Word Pops" image twice onto Kraft Layering Paper using Snow Chalk Ink. Trim, and adhere towards the center of a sheet of Snow Layering Paper as shown.
2. Adhere a 1 1/4" strip of patterned paper directly below, and a very thin strip of blue paper directly above.
3. Adhere a 4 x 6 photo approximately 1/2" from the left hand side.
4. Adhere a width of ribbon directly below the photo, and a 1 1/2" strip of Grass Layering Paper directly below the patterned paper. Top the Grass Layering Paper with a decorative edge created using Snow Layering Paper and a border punch. Add a machine stitching detail if desired.
5. For a finishing touch, adhere a small butterfly accent punched from Daffodil Layering Paper, and a variety of Blush Buttons.
6. Spray a sheet of Carnation Layering Paper with pink glimmer mist to add a subtle sparkle. Once dry, stamp the two large flowers using VersaMark, top with white embossing powder, and heat set. Carefully cut the images out just outside of the lines. Color the inside of the swirls with a bright pink colored pencil, and adhere flowers to page. Apply several small pearl accents to the centers.
7. Spray a sheet of Grass Layering Paper with marshmallow glimmer mist and blot. Once dry, stamp the leaf images with VersaMark, top with white embossing powder and heat set. Cut the images out, just outside of the lines, and adhere beneath the flower's petals.
8. Stamp the sentiment onto a double ended banner cut from Kraft Layering Paper. Adhere to page, securing with a staple on the right side.
9. Computer generate journaling, cut out using a circle punch, and mat onto a larger scalloped circle punched from kraft paper.
